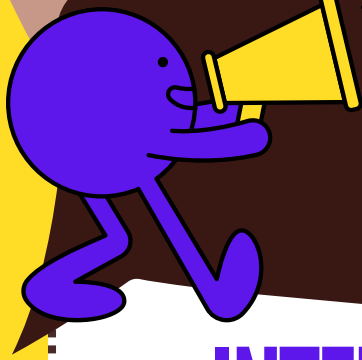

ERASMUS STUDY MOBILITY

WE WELCOMED TWO SECOND-YEAR BTS TOURISM STUDENTS, LAURA MOLINA VILCHEZ AND DAVID PLATA MONTES, FOR A TWO-MONTH STUDY MOBILITY PLACEMENT AT OUR INSTITUTION. THEY STUDY AT CIFP HURTADO DE MENDOZA IN GRANADA, OUR PARTNER SCHOOL. DURING THEIR STAY, THEY HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO DISCOVER OUR REGION AS WELL AS EXPERIENCE HIGHER EDUCATION IN FRANCE.

ADDITIONALLY, TWO FIRST-YEAR GENERAL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS, EMY AND LILOU, TOOK PART IN A 15-DAY STUDY MOBILITY PROGRAM AT IES ALBA LONGA HIGH SCHOOL IN GRANADA (SPAIN). THEY WERE FULLY IMMERSSED FOR TWO WEEKS: THEY ATTENDED CLASSES WITH THEIR EXCHANGE PARTNERS AND WERE HOSTED BY THEIR FAMILIES, MAKING THIS A TRULY UNIQUE EXPERIENCE.
